Personal advisor

As a member you are assigned a personal forest inspector, who is a forestry management specialist in the area where your business forest is located. Your inspector will assist you in all aspects of forest ownership, taking into account your current circumstances and goals.

Your local area

As a member you belong to a local forestry area (called a sbo), depending on where your forest is located. In each forestry area there is a 'sbo council' consisting of elected members that organize local member activities, support field staff and provide help to you if needed.

You can participate in local activities free of charge, which provide you with the perfect opportunity to meet other forest owners and exchange knowledge and experiences. A calendar of upcoming activities can be found at norraskog.se, on our app or via our social media channels.

Our services

No matter how much forest you own, what you already know about forestry or what you may need help with, we are here to guide you.

Road office: Road services including new construction, road maintenance, share calculations, etc.

Forestry school: Theoretical training in, among other things: 'value-creating forestry', 'your forest economy' and 'the cycle of a working forest'. In-depth practical training in forest clearing and the use of chainsaws.

location for mushroom picking and
family outings).

Ownership Agreement you will
also receive a copy of 'My Forest

Overview' - which details your forest's
development and finances, and
even tells you how much your forest's
annual growth is contributing to carbon dioxide absorption.

Norra Timber operates three sawmills, three processing units and a utility pole factory. All the timber delivered to the association is processed here.

As a member, you are also a co-owner of Husum Pulp AB, where


pulpwood and chips from our sawmills are transformed into climate-friendly products. Any by-products are used by turbines and turned into 'green' electricity.

Timber from northern Sweden is renowned for its high quality and is in demand both locally and internationally. Norra Timber currently exports timber to 37 countries around the world. Our timber is also delivered to established chains of builders merchants throughout Sweden.

Our promise to you

As a valued member we want you to have confidence in Norra Skog. It is important to us that you are well-informed, feel confident in your role as an entrepreneur, and are motivated to make the most out of your forests. To achieve this we're committed to creating membership benefits for you.

That's why you will:

- Be appointed a dedicated forest inspector.
- · Receive feedback on weekdays within 24 hours of your request.
- Always be informed, as a co-owner of the property, when signing an agreement.
- Receive a notification from a contractor before any assignment begins.
- Be given ongoing updates about your assignments via our members app.
- Receive a felling report within 30 days of your trees being felled.
- Receive an invoice within 20 days of any completed forestry management work.
- Be sent clear and concise invoices and statements.
- Be offered an annual personal meeting if you have a Forest Ownership Agreement.
- Get a fast response and professional service in the event of any discrepancy/complaint.
